Lab Dissections

Your dissection kit includes:

- 1. Dissecting Pan—with paper towel insert
- 2. Ruler
- 3. Mall Probe
- 4. Pipette Dropper
- 5. Dissecting Scissors
- 6. Scalpel
- 7. Forceps
- 8. Magnifying Glass
- 9. Dissecting Needle
- 10. Dissecting Pins (6)

Rules:

- 1. Treat all specimens with respect.
- 2. Leave the paper towel in the dissecting pan while you dissect. (This assures easier clean-up.)
- 3. Use extreme caution. Dissecting tools are sharp.
- 4. Only make cuts/incisions or remove limbs etc. when directed to do so by written instructions or unless Mrs. Donley tells you to.
- Replace the paper towel with a fresh one when cleaning up after a dissection. (Unless they change the paper towel dispenser again, hitting the paper towel dispenser lever 5 times will give the proper length of paper towel for the pan.)
- 6. Make sure that all dissecting tools are clean and place them back in their appropriate compartments of the tool case.
- 7. Put dissecting tool case in your dissecting pan in the open position.
- 8. Replace the dissecting pan in the cupboard (in number order).
- 9. Dispose of specimens as you are told by Mrs. Donley. DO NOT TAKE ANY SPECIMEN PARTS OUTSIDE THE CLASSROOM!!!
