







What should my microscope drawings look like?

They should look exactly like what you see when you look in the microscope, but don't draw in the pointer.

The drawings as they should not appear: Why are they incorrect? They don't show what is actually seen.

In the top drawing: It is really just a bunch of scribbles that don't look like much of anything.

The middle drawing: Only three of the cells are drawn, they are not correct sizes, the cells are not shown in their proper orientation, they are not very detailed.

In the bottom drawing: There are only two cells drawn, they are drawn much larger than they actually are, shown very "sketchy", the pointer is drawn in.
